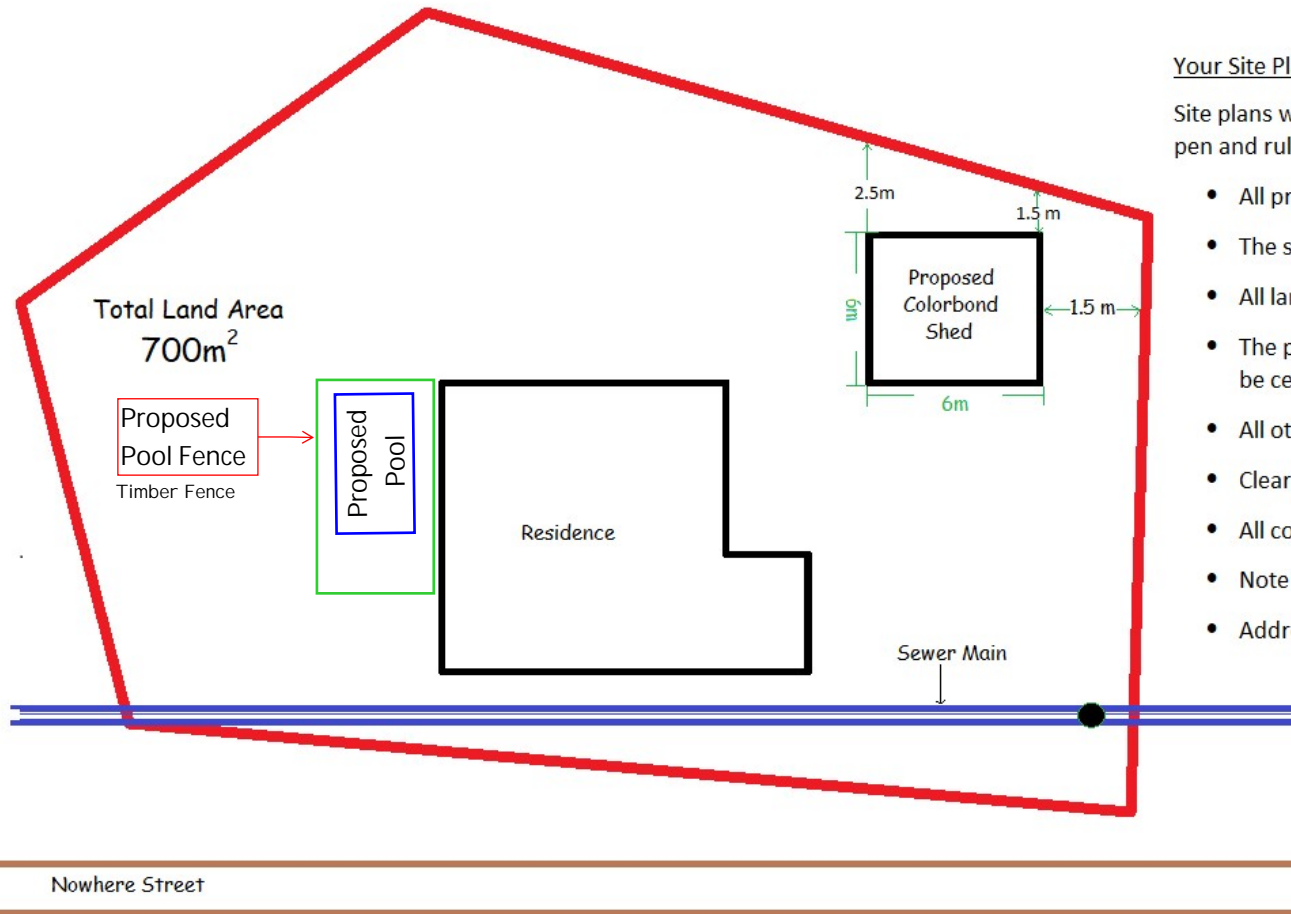


# EXAMPLE OF A TYPICAL SITE PLAN



## Your Site Plan Must Show

Site plans will **ONLY** be accepted if drawn on plain paper using a pen and ruler

- All property boundaries (the shape of your block)
- The size of the block in m2
- All landmarks ie on rural blocks show roads and dams
- The proposed building or project; Clearly labelling what is to be certified as part of this application ie proposed shed
- All other buildings on the block ie house, sheds etc
- Clear measurements that are readable
- All council sewer mains, man holes and easements
- Note all roads that go near the property
- Address, Lot & Plan and Owners Name

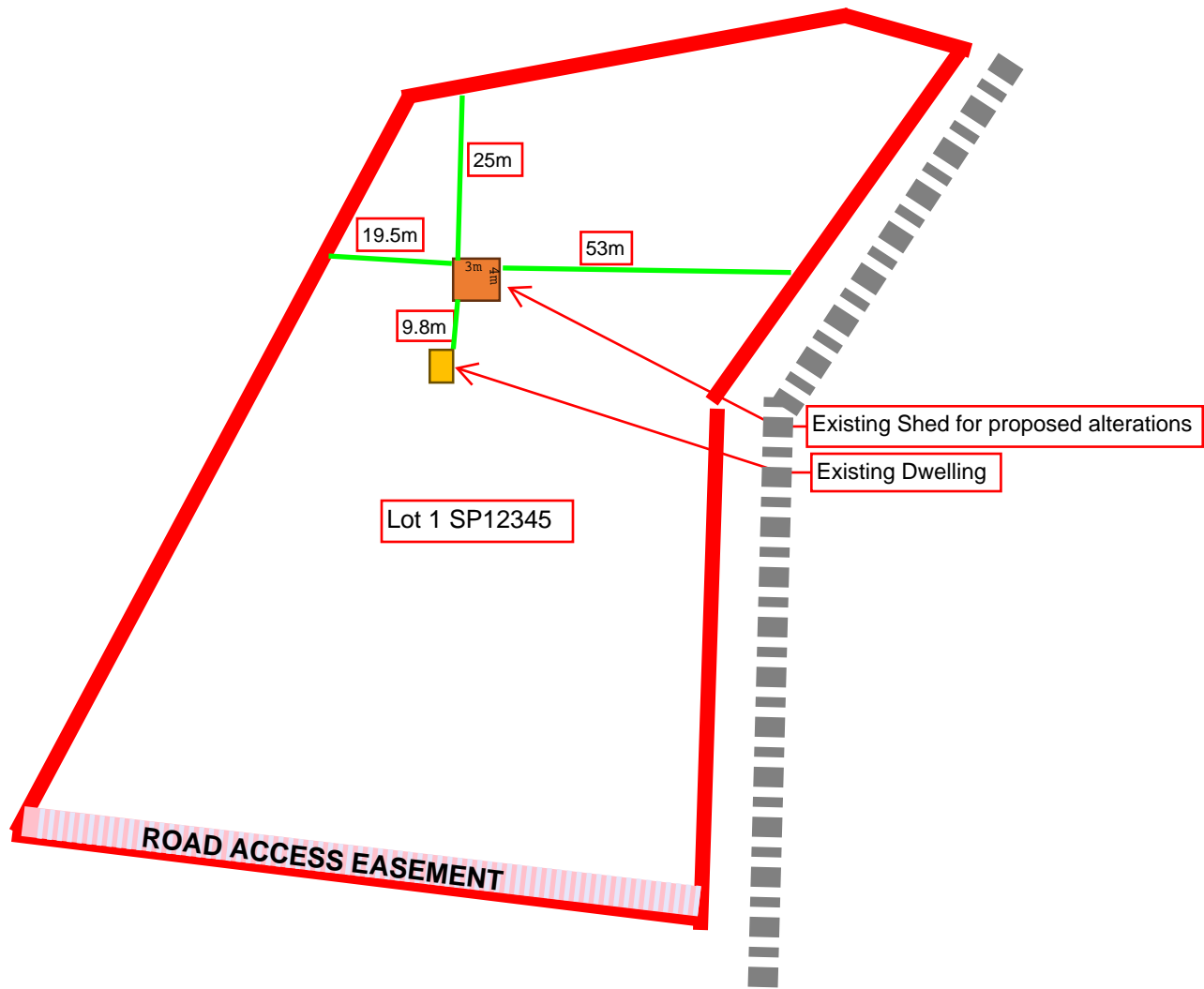
